



APPLICATION PROCESS

Any Midlothian pupil aged 16+ can apply for the Leadership Academy. An application form must be completed and submitted, and applicants will be subject to selection by High School PE Departments & Active School Coordinators.

Successful pupils will then be invited into the Leadership Academy via an agreement letter.

Pupils may be undergoing a minimum of National 5 PE and working towards leadership & development modules - For Example - Dance Leadership, Sport & Recreation and Sports Leaders, This is not essential and is also open to any other leadership modules non sport specific.

Pupils who wish to apply should have a keen interest in developing organisation, communication and leadership skills.

PROGRAMME SUMMARY

The purpose of the **Active Schools Leadership Academy** is to develop leadership experience and employability to aspiring young people.

Participants will be asked to commit to a full calendar of training/workshops. All training will be delivered from a neutral venue and will take place after school on a Friday.

Following this, pupils are expected to undertake a placement assisting with sport within local schools.

All training & placements will be co-ordinated and supported by Active Schools.
