What's it all about?

To celebrate the **Glasgow 2014 Commonwealth Games**, the 2014 Commonwealth Passport aims to encourage our young people to get active and enjoy a range of Commonwealth sports. The Passport is open to pupils in P4 to P7 on the 1st of July 2013.

How can I get involved?

Just take part in a Commonwealth Sport between **1st July 2013** and **Sunday 30th March 2014**. Take your Commonwealth Passport along to the session and ask the witness to sign to confirm your attendance. A witness can be a coach, teacher or a member of staff at the facility you are using.

How can I find out about activities?

Commonwealth activity sessions for all abilities/disabilities will be advertised on the Midlothian Council and the Active Midlothian website. New dates and times to try activities will be added from time to time so check out the **Active Midlothian Website** – www.activemidlothian.org.uk or talk to your Active Schools Coordinator.

What is Club 2014?

Club 2014 gives you the chance to get some points for sports and activities that don't feature in the Commonwealth or Olympic Games but are popular in Midlothian. There are quite a number of them but since we really want you to try lots of activities we are limiting the number of points you can get for Club 2014 to 30.

How much does it cost?

Session costs will vary. Please see details on websites for further information.

Will I be rewarded for taking part?

All sports have been awarded 10 points and medals will be allocated based on the following total points.

CERTIFICATE: **30 points** BRONZE MEDAL: **40-80 points** SILVER MEDAL: **90-150 points** GOLD MEDAL: **160-260 points**

In addition if you achieve a **Gold Medal** you will be put into a prize draw and get the opportunity to carry the Commonwealth Baton when it travels through Midlothian.
