#### CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

- 1 Confirmation of enrolment will be forwarded to a course member on receipt of an application form, which must be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Payment of fee will be considered of a course member's acceptance of these conditions of enrolment.
- 2 \*Applications are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Although applications will be accepted up to course commencement, it should be noted that a course will be cancelled if there are insufficient applicants 21 days prior to commencement.
- The Association/Community Coach/Football Development Officer reserves the right to cancel or amend the arrangements for any course. In this event, any course member unable to transfer to an alternative course will be issued with a full refund, and the Association/Community Coach/Football Development Officer will not be responsible for any further compensation.
- 4 Intimation of cancellation on a course member's part must be given in writing, and received by the Association at least seven days prior to course commencement. In this event, a full refund will be issued.
- 5 Insurance cover will be provided, although this will not extend to damage or loss to a course member's personal property.
- 6 The course member agrees to abide by the rules laid down by the Association and its staff.
- 7 The information provided on this form will be shared with the Scottish FA for the purposes of counting and monitoring participation in football and will not be used for any commercial purpose or shared with any third party organisations.


